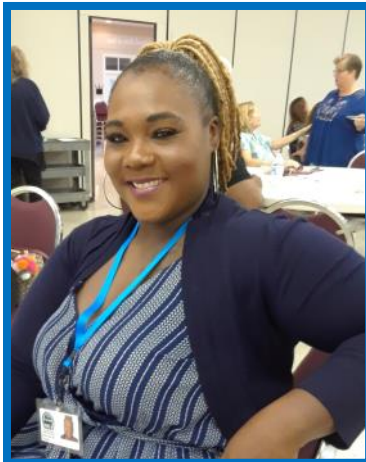

As we outgrew our service site on Pennsylvania Avenue, Bob Cook donated the property on North Woodland Boulevard for administration.
